2020 Q2 Chief Advisor - Secretariat Joint Meeting

Impact of the COVID-19 pandemic is taking a toll on the global economy and politics. Governments and businesses around the world are all eyeing for economy recovery. In this context, CCICED is preparing a set of policy recommendations to the State Council with an aim to contribute to the development of the 14th Five-Year Plan. These recommendations will address the policy responses in relation to the current global economic shock.

On April 29th and 30th, CCICED held its quarterly Chief Advisor-Secretariat Joint Meeting to update the research progress of its ten ongoing SPS projects and to solicit inputs from Members and Special Advisors on the proposed policy recommendations to the 14th Five-Year Plan. The Meeting was held via virtual conference and was actively participated by near 200 participants at each session. Summary records of the meetings will be circulated via the newsletter in the coming weeks.

At the end of the meeting, the Chief Advisors announced that after considering all inputs collected, they will formulate a draft policy recommendation in the next few weeks, at which point Council Members will have the opportunity to provide written comments to the draft before it is finalized for submission.

10,000 Chinese sturgeons released into Yangtze River April 25th, CGTN - On April 22, 2020, a total of 10,000

Chinese sturgeons was released into Yangtze River in Yichang city, Hubei province in central China. This is the 62nd release by The Chinese Sturgeon Research Institute of Three Gorges Corp, also the largest scale in recent years. According to statistics from WWF, a total of 5,030,000 Chinese sturgeons has been released in China since 1984. China to cut new energy vehicle subsidies by 10% this year

April 23rd, Reuters - China will cut subsidies on new energy vehicles (NEV) such as electric cars by 10% this year, the finance ministry said, following a decision last month to continue providing incentives to buy cleaner cars. The government had announced plans in 2015 to end the subsidies this year, but said in March it would extend them. Tesla Inc's China-made Model 3 sedans, meanwhile, are currently priced at 323,800 yuan before subsidies, meaning the U.S. electric car pioneer will have to reduce the price to qualify for the scheme. 


